COMMUNITY GIVING APPLICATION

1. Introductory Statement

Established in 1957, The Summit League, Inc. is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization consisting of 50 Active Members and over 60 Sustaining Members, who raise funds in the areas of the arts, education, health, and/or welfare to benefit charitable organizations in Santa Clara County. In 2023 Summit League established a Community Giving Fund to provide year-round opportunities to non-profits in the areas of arts, education, health and/or welfare, and to respond to emergency needs in Santa Clara County.

In the remainder of 2023 through August 2024, Summit League has allocated the sum of \$40,000 to respond to grant requests from local non-profits.

The process for receiving a Community Grant is intended to be a simple process with applying agencies generally receiving funds within 90 days, apart from applications for emergency funds, which will be expedited. Grant requests can be made for a program, project, or capital improvement project. Community Giving grants require the majority vote of the Active membership of Summit League.
